Aims of the call



- To bring together diverse stakeholders to tackle translational challenges in PM, thereby facilitating the acceleration of integration of research findings into everyday clinical practice
- To maximise the impact of prior investments in the framework of ERA/EP PerMed by building on the results of previously funded consortia, fostering deeper collaboration and inter-consortium synergy

These aims must be met by:

- Connecting researchers who represent a previously funded ERA and/or EP PerMed project to form a new consortium for enhanced networking and collaboration
- Engaging with key translational stakeholders who bring expertise on advancing PM towards clinical implementation. These stakeholders may include clinicians, research nurses, healthcare providers, implementation specialists, Health Technology Assessment (HTA) experts, patient and citizens advocacy organisations (PAOs), regulators, policymakers, and others

Format of the event



NSC2025 provides financial support to organise a single networking event

Applicants can choose between two formats:

- A face-to-face (in-person) meeting
- A hybrid meeting, where participants are present at a physical location and additional participants are present online

Important notes



- Total funding budget NSC2025 is €500,000
- Maximum budget for a single networking event is €30,000
- The awarded consortia have one year to organise a single networking event using the awarded budget
- The event can be organised as a workshop or conference
- The focus of the event should be the translation of PM research into healthcare, clinical applications and/or prevention
- Networking events supported by EP PerMed need to be collaborative, interdisciplinary and involve cross border participation

In addition, applicants are highly encouraged to consider the following aspects:

- Involvement of early career researchers
- International cooperation as a follow-up to the EC's vision
- Involvement of both clinical and pre-clinical groups

Expected outcome and impact



- The outcome of networks funded in the framework of the NSC should be enhanced collaboration in PM enabling the implementation of PM research into healthcare, clinical applications and prevention
- The **output** of networks funded in the NSC must be a **report about the event**, where the results of the findings and discussions of the event, expected outcomes and impact of the enhanced collaboration are described. In this report anticipated future output can be mentioned, e.g. publications, roadmaps, analyses, new clinical guidelines or medical recommendations

02	Eligibility criteria





- A consortium submitting an application must be transnational, involving a minimum of three applicants employed at different organisations from at least three different countries participating in EP PerMed at the time of the application
- One of the minimum three applicants must act as principal applicant and the others as co-applicants
- The networking event must take place in one of the countries participating in EP PerMed at time of application
- The maximum budget that can be requested per NSC application is € 30.000
- Budget can be used to cover activities such as the organisation of a face-to-face and/or hybrid meeting, e.g. renting a meeting venue, catering, travel and accommodation costs of speakers, etc

N.B.: experimental research activities (e.g. costs for research equipment or consumables) and salaries for scientific or other staff or student stipends etcetera are <u>not</u> eligible for funding

Eligibility criteria

Principal applicant



- The **organisation** of the principal applicant has to be a **legal entity** and established in a country participating in EP PerMed at the time of application
- The principal applicant must be a **researcher** that is or was acting as a coordinator or partner **in a project funded by ERA PerMed or EP PerMed**
- The principal applicant must have an **employment relationship** with an organisation that meets the definition of a research organisation as referred to in EU state aid legislation (Framework for state aid for research and development and innovation (2014/C 198/01)
 - Usually, this means that the principal applicant is employed at a university
- The principal applicant cannot participate in more than one application as principal applicant in the NSC2025 call

Eligibility criteria

Co-applicants (2-7 persons)



- At least one of the co-applicants (1 person) must be a researcher who is either a coordinator or a partner in a project previously funded by ERA PerMed or EP PerMed. This project must be different from the project of the principal applicant
- A maximum of 2 co-applicants can represent the same previously funded project

The other co-applicant(s) can be:

- A researcher from a country participating in EP PerMed at the time of application who is involved in a (inter)national project related to health research towards PM approaches
- A **translational stakeholder**, facilitating transition from research results into implementation in daily clinical practice. In this call, the translational expert can be a clinician or research nurse, healthcare provider, implementation specialist, Health Technology Assessment expert, citizen/patient advocacy organisation (PAO), regulator or policy maker



Role principal applicant



- The principal applicant will serve as the representative of the network, both externally and to the NSC Secretariat at ZonMw, The Netherlands
- He/she will be the sole contact person on behalf of the network for communication with EP PerMed
- The organisation of the principal applicant will receive the funding on behalf of the network and will be held accountable for the management of the expenses of the networking event
- The principal applicant has to communicate all relevant information from the NSC Secretariat to the co-applicants
- The principal applicant is also responsible for submitting both the financial report and the scientific report of the networking event

Role co-applicants



- The co-applicants (maximum 7) will organise the networking event together with principal applicant
- The applying network should consist of partners who will develop **scientific** programme of networking event, **logistic** organiser(s)/local organiser(s) of networking event and/or partners involved in **communication** and/or **finances**. The division of this work for organising networking event is responsibility of co-applicants together with principal applicant

Stakeholder analysis



- In the application form, a stakeholder analysis must be described
- The **goal** of this stakeholder analysis is to ensure that all relevant stakeholders are involved in the organisation of the event or participate in the event
- The **stakeholders** may be involved in the network as **co-applicants** but may also provide input as **speaker** or **participant**
- The number and type of stakeholders **may be expanded** in the course of organising the event, when additional input is necessary





- Both should be prepared in time before 29 September 2025 14:00 CEST

- One account per proposal
- Principal applicant:
 - Collects all relevant information
 - Fills in the forms
 - Uploads the filled-in templates as pdf
 - Submits the proposal
- All partners should be involved

Evaluation criteria



Evaluation criteria:

- 1) Excellence
- 2) Impact
- 3) Quality and efficiency of the implementation

Scoring system:

0: Failure. The application fails to address the criterion or cannot be assessed due to missing or incomplete information

- 1: Poor. The criterion is inadequately addressed, or there are serious inherent weaknesses
- 2: Fair. The application broadly addresses criterion, but there are significant weaknesses
- 3: Good. The application addresses criterion well, but a number of shortcomings are present
- **4: Very Good.** The application addresses criterion very well, but a small number of shortcomings are present
- **5: Excellent.** The application successfully addresses all relevant aspects of criterion. Any shortcomings are minor

Evaluation criteria



- The three main evaluation criteria are given equal weight
- The maximum total score that can be achieved for the main evaluation criteria is 15 points
- Each application must at least have a score of <u>3</u> for each individual main evaluation criterion and a total score for all main evaluation criteria of at least <u>10</u> to be eligible for funding
- All applications will be ranked according to the overall score in a ranking list

Projects selected for funding



Process after selection:

- The principal applicants have to download their application as a PDF from PT-Outline system and upload it to electronic submission system of ZonMw
- ZonMw will send a letter to the principal applicant containing grant decision, obligations and applicable terms and conditions
- The principal applicant is accountable for the expenses of networking event

Reporting requirements:

On behalf of all applicants, the principal applicant must submit:

- An abstract of networking event suitable for communication (upon notification)
- A scientific report on outcomes of the networking event (2 months after event)
- A financial report containing relevant supporting documents (2 months after event)
