

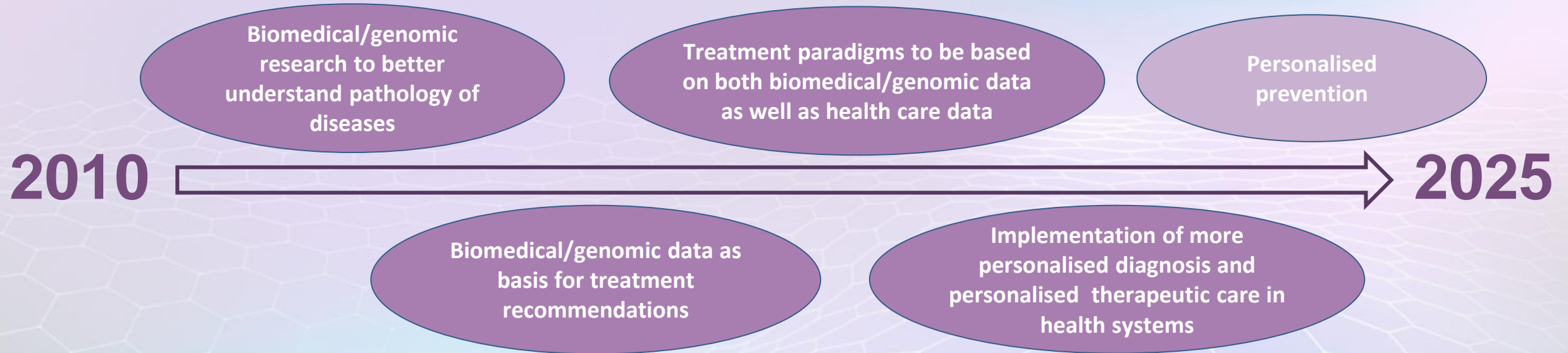

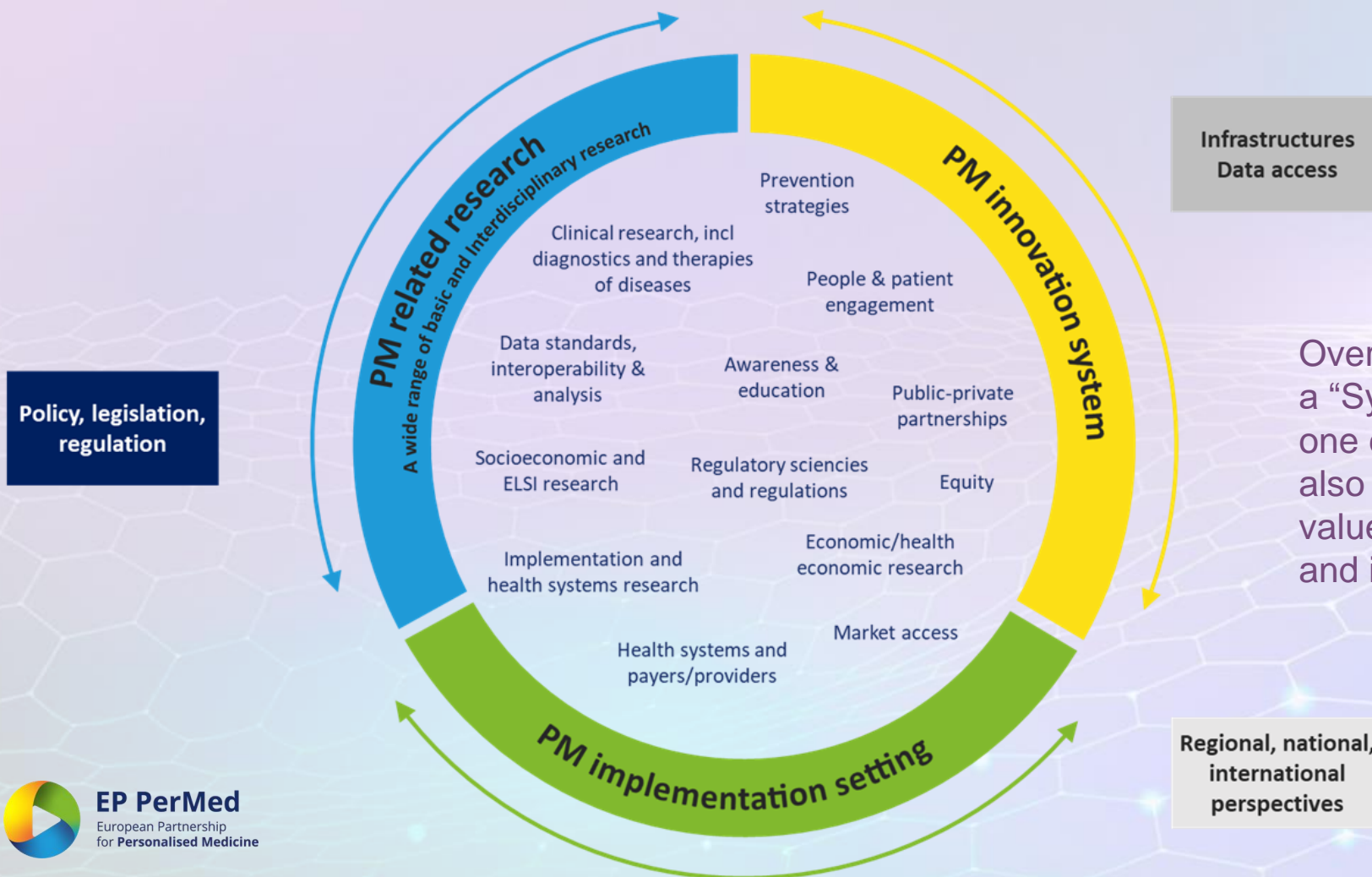


**PM is now considered a key basis for our future healthcare systems**
